3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DATE FOR DEVELOPMENT OF**  
4 **AUTOMATED ENTRY-EXIT CONTROL SYSTEM.**

5 Section 110 of division C of Public Law 104–208 is  
6 amended by striking “2 years after the date of enactment  
7 of this Act” and inserting “October 15, 1998”.
