6       The requirement of section 1903(m)(2)(A)(ii) of the  
7       Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396b(m)(2)(A)(ii)) is  
8       waived with respect to facilities of HealthCare USA, Inc.  
9       and Ultramedix Health Care Systems Inc. operating in

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- 1 Florida for contract periods beginning on July 1, 1996,
- 2 and ending on June 30, 1999.

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
