3 The Federal building located at 100 Alabama Street
4 NW, in Atlanta, Georgia, shall be known and designated
5 as the “Sam Nunn Federal Center”.

6 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

7 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
8 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
9 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
10 a reference to the “Sam Nunn Federal Center”.
