A BILL

To amend the National Labor Relations Act and the Railway Labor Act to repeal the provisions of the Acts that require employees to pay union dues or fees as a condition of employment.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Right to
5 Work Act of 1997”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO THE NATIONAL LABOR RELA-**
2 **TIONS ACT.**

3 (a) RIGHTS OF EMPLOYEES.—Section 7 of the Na-
4 tional Labor Relations Act (29 U.S.C. 157) is amended
5 by striking “except to” and all that follows through “au-
6 thorized in section 8(a)(3)”.

7 (b) UNFAIR LABOR PRACTICES.—Section 8 of the
8 National Labor Relations Act (29 U.S.C. 158) is amend-
9 ed—

10 (1) in subsection (a)(3), by striking “: *Provided,*
11 *That*” and all that follows through “retaining mem-
12 bership”;

13 (2) in subsection (b)—

14 (A) in paragraph (2), by striking “or to
15 discriminate” and all that follows through “re-
16 taining membership”; and

17 (B) in paragraph (5), by striking “covered
18 by an agreement authorized under subsection
19 (a)(3)”;

20 (3) in subsection (f)—

21 (A) by striking paragraph (2);

22 (B) by redesignating paragraphs (3) and
23 (4) as paragraphs (2) and (3), respectively; and

24 (C) by striking “*Provided, That*” and all
25 that follows through “section 8(a)(3) of this

1 Act: *Provided further,*” and inserting “*Pro-*
2 *vided,*”.

3 **SEC. 3. AMENDMENT TO THE RAILWAY LABOR ACT.**

4 Section 2 of the Railway Labor Act (45 U.S.C. 152)
5 is amended by striking paragraph Eleventh.
