Mr. MOYNIHAN (for himself and Mr. SARBANES) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To authorize the Government of India to establish a memorial to honor Mahatma Gandhi in the District of Columbia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH MEMORIAL.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Government of India is au-
5 thorized to establish a memorial to honor Mahatma Gan-
6 dhi on the Federal land in the District of Columbia de-
7 scribed in subsection (b).

8 (b) LOCATION OF MEMORIAL.—The Federal land re-
9 ferred to in subsection (a) is the triangle of land in the

1 District of Columbia that is bordered by 21st Street, NW.,
2 Q Street, NW., and Massachusetts Avenue, NW., and des-
3 igned as plot number 58 in Area II on the map num-
4 bered 869/86501 and dated May 1, 1986, which is located
5 across Massachusetts Avenue, NW., from the Embassy of
6 India.

7 (c) COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMO-
8 RATIVE WORKS.—The establishment of the memorial shall
9 be in accordance with the Commemorative Works Act (40
10 U.S.C. 1001 et seq.).

11 (d) LIMITATION ON PAYMENT OF EXPENSES.—The
12 Government of the United States shall not pay any ex-
13 pense of the establishment of the memorial.
