Mr. GREGG (for Mr. LOTT) submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment or recess of the Senate and House of Representatives.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That when the Senate recesses or adjourns
3 at the close of business on Thursday, May 21, 1998, Fri-
4 day, May 22, 1998, Saturday, May 23, 1998, or Sunday,
5 May 24, 1998, pursuant to a motion made by the Majority
6 Leader or his designee in accordance with this concurrent
7 resolution, it stands recessed or adjourned until noon on
8 Monday, June 1, 1998, or until such time on that day
9 as may be specified by the Majority Leader or his designee
10 in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until noon on the

1 second day after Members are notified to reassemble pur-
2 suant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever
3 occurs first; and that when the House adjourns on the
4 legislative day of Friday, May 22, 1998, or Saturday, May
5 23, 1998, pursuant to a motion made by the Majority
6 Leader or his designee in accordance with this concurrent
7 resolution, it stand adjourned until 2:00 p.m. on Wednes-
8 day, June 3, 1998, or until noon on the second day after
9 Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to section
10 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

11 SEC. 2. The Majority Leader of the Senate and the
12 Speaker of the House, acting jointly after consultation
13 with the Minority Leader of the Senate and the Minority
14 Leader of the House, shall notify the Members of the Sen-
15 ate and House, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
16 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
