5 **CREW OF THE U.S.S. INDIANAPOLIS.**

6 (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of the Con-
7 gress that the President should award a Presidential Unit
8 Citation to the final crew of the U.S.S. INDIANAPOLIS

1 (CA-35) in recognition of the courage and fortitude dis-
2 played by the members of that crew in the face of extraor-
3 dinary hardship and adversity after their ship was
4 torpedoed and sunk on July 30, 1945.

5 (b) WAIVER OF TIME LIMITATION.—A citation de-
6 scribed in subsection (a) may be made without regard to
7 any provision of law or regulation prescribing a time limi-
8 tation that is otherwise applicable with respect to rec-
9 ommendation for, or the award of, such a citation.
