

WAIVING A REQUIREMENT OF CLAUSE 4(b) OF RULE XI
WITH RESPECT TO CONSIDERATION OF CERTAIN RESO-
LUTIONS REPORTED FROM THE COMMITTEE ON RULES

REPORT

[To accompany H. Res. 155]

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 155, by a nonrecord vote, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

BRIEF SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION

The resolution waives clause 4(b) of rule XI, requiring a two-thirds vote to consider a rule on the same day as it is reported from the Committee on Rules, against the same-day consideration of any resolution reported before May 23, 1997, providing for consideration of specified measures.

The resolution applies to a concurrent resolution of the budget, an amendment thereto, a conference report thereon, or an amendment reported in disagreement from a conference thereon. It also applies to the bill H.R. 1469, making emergency supplemental appropriations for recovery from natural disasters, and for overseas peacekeeping efforts, including those in Bosnia, for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1997, and for other purposes, an amendment thereto, a conference report thereon, or an amendment reported in disagreement from a conference thereon.
