Mr. ROGERS submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Correcting the enrollment of H.R. 1180.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That, in the enrollment of the bill (H.R.
3 1180), to amend the Social Security Act to expand the
4 availability of health care coverage for working individuals
5 with disabilities, to establish a Ticket to Work and Self-
6 Sufficiency Program in the Social Security Administration
7 to provide such individuals with meaningful opportunities
8 to work, and for other purposes, the Clerk of the House
9 of Representative shall make the following correction:
10 Strike section 408 and insert the following:

1 **“SEC. 408. CLIMATE DATABASE MODERNIZATION.**

2 “Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Na-
3 tional Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration shall ini-
4 tiate a new competitive contract procurement for its multi-
5 year program for key entry of valuable climate records,
6 archive services, and database development in accordance
7 with existing Federal procurement laws and regulations.”.
