CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Honoring the service and sacrifice during periods of war by members of the United States merchant marine.

- Whereas throughout the history of the United States, the United States merchant marine has served the Nation during periods of war;
- Whereas vessels of the United States merchant marine fleet, such as the S.S. LANE VICTORY, provided critical logistical support to the Armed Forces by carrying equipment, supplies, and personnel necessary to maintain war efforts;
- Whereas numerous members of the United States merchant marine have died to secure peace and freedom; and
- Whereas at a time when the people of the United States are recognizing the contributions of the Armed Forces and civilian personnel to the national security, it is appropriate to recognize the service of the United States merchant marine: Now, therefore, be it

1	Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate
2	concurring), That the Congress—
3	(1) honors the service and sacrifice during peri-
4	ods of war by members of the United States mer-
5	chant marine;
6	(2) recognizes the critical role played by vessels
7	of the United States merchant marine fleet, such as
8	the S.S. LANE VICTORY, in transporting equip-
9	ment, supplies, and personnel necessary to support
10	war efforts; and
11	(3) encourages—
12	(A) the American people, through appro-
13	priate ceremonies and activities, to recognize
14	and commemorate the service and sacrifices of
15	the United States merchant marine; and
16	(B) all government agencies to take appro-
17	priate steps to commemorate the United States
18	merchant marine.
