CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for corrections in the enrollment of the bill H.R.
4461.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That, in the enrollment of the bill (H.R.
3 4461) making appropriations for Agriculture, Rural De-
4 velopment, Food and Drug Administration, and Related
5 Agencies programs for the fiscal year ending September
6 30, 2001, and for other purposes, the Clerk of the House
7 shall make the following corrections:

8 (1) In section 1(a), insert before the period at
9 the end the following: “, except that—

1 “(1) section 903(b) of H.R. 5426 is deemed to
2 read as follows:

3 ‘(b) EXISTING SANCTIONS.—The President shall ter-
4 minate any unilateral agricultural sanction or unilateral
5 medical sanction that is in effect as of the date of the
6 enactment of this Act (except any such sanction that is
7 applicable to Iran, Libya, Syria, or Sudan).’; and

8 “(2) section 906(a)(1) is deemed to be amended
9 by striking ‘(other than section 904)’ and inserting
10 ‘(other than sections 903(b) and 904)’.”.

11 (2) In section 1(b), insert before the period at
12 the end the following: “, except that in such appen-
13 dix the text of section 903(b) shall be the text for
14 such section that is described in subsection (a)(1) of
15 this section and the text of section 906(a)(1) shall
16 be the text for such section as amended by sub-
17 section (a)(2) of this section”.
