## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for the sine die adjournment of the second session of the One Hundred Sixth Congress.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-  
3 tive day of Friday, December 15, 2000, Saturday, Decem-  
4 ber 16, 2000, or Sunday, December 17, 2000, on a motion  
5 offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Ma-  
6 jority Leader or his designee, it shall stand adjourned sine  
7 die, or until noon on the second day after Members are  
8 notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concur-  
9 rent resolution; and that when the Senate adjourns on Fri-  
10 day, December 15, 2000, Saturday, December 16, 2000,

1 or Sunday, December 17, 2000, on a motion offered pur-  
2 suant to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader  
3 or his designee, it shall stand adjourned sine die, or until  
4 noon on the second day after Members are notified to reas-  
5 semble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution.

6       SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority  
7 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with  
8 the Majority Leader of the House and the Minority Leader  
9 of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House and  
10 Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in their opin-  
11 ion, the public interest shall warrant it.
