A BILL

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Federal Employee
- 5 Right to Know Payroll Act".

1	SEC. 2. DISCLOSURE OF FEDERAL GOVERNMENT'S SHARE
2	OF FICA AND MEDICARE TAX AND PAYROLL
3	ALLOCATION.
4	(a) In General.—Each department, agency, or in-
5	strumentality of the United States that provides a pay-
6	check to an employee shall include on each such paycheck
7	information on—
8	(1) the total amount of tax imposed with re-
9	spect to the employee, during the period covered by
10	the paycheck, on the department, agency, or instru-
11	mentality under subsections (a) and (b) of section
12	3111 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986; and
13	(2) the estimated payroll allocation of the de-
14	partment, agency, or instrumentality with respect to
15	the employee for the period, which is the sum of—
16	(A) the amounts referred to in paragraph
17	(1); and
18	(B) the amount referred to in section
19	6051(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986
20	with respect to the employee for the period.
21	(b) Effective Date.—Subsection (a) shall apply
22	with respect remuneration paid after December 31, 2000.
