- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Public Services Flexi-
- 3 bility Act".
- 4 SEC. 2. PUBLIC SERVICES CAP.
- 5 Section 105(a)(8) of the Housing and Community
- 6 Development Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(8)) is
- 7 amended by striking "in each of fiscal years 1993" and
- 8 all that follows through "unit of general local government"
- 9 and inserting the following: "in any fiscal year to the City
- 10 of Los Angeles, the County of Los Angeles, or any other
- 11 unit of general local government located in the County of
- 12 Los Angeles, such city, such county, or each such unit of
- 13 general local government, respectively,".

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
