A BILL

To prohibit the use of funds appropriated to the Department of Defense from being used for the deployment of ground elements of the United States Armed Forces in Kosovo unless that deployment is specifically authorized by law.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. FINDINGS.
- 4 The Congress makes the following findings:

- 1 (1) United States national security interests in 2 Kosovo do not rise to a level that warrants the intro-3 duction of ground troops by the United States.
 - (2) Kosovo is a province of the Republic of Serbia, a sovereign state.
 - (3) An Act of Congress is necessary for the introduction of the Armed Forces of the United States into hostilities, or situations where imminent involvement in hostilities is clearly indicated by the circumstances, when such action is not required for the defense of the United States, its Armed Forces, or its nationals.
 - (4) The lessons of the United States military involvement in Vietnam and Bosnia clearly argue that the costs and duration of any such deployment will be much heavier and much longer than initially foreseen.
 - (5) The Congress and the American people have the greatest pride in the members of the Armed Forces and strongly support them.
