3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

6 nois, is hereby designated as the “John J. Buchanan Post
7 Office Building”. Any reference to such facility in a law,

1 regulation, map, document, paper, or other record of the
2 United States shall be considered to be a reference to the
3 “John J. Buchanan Post Office Building”.
