4 referred to in section 1 shall be considered to be a ref-  
5 erence to the “John J. Buchanan Post Office Building”.

6 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

7 *The facility of the United States Postal Service, located*  
8 *at 9308 South Chicago Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, 60617, is*  
9 *designated as the “John J. Buchanan Post Office Build-*  
10 *ing”.*

11 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

12 *Any reference in a law, regulation, map, document,*  
13 *paper, or other record of the United States to the facility*  
14 *referred to in section 1 shall be considered to be a reference*  
15 *to the “John J. Buchanan Post Office Building”.*
