## A BILL

To make technical corrections to the Omnibus Parks and  
Public Lands Management Act of 1996.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE; REFERENCE TO OMNIBUS PARKS**  
2 **AND PUBLIC LANDS MANAGEMENT ACT OF**  
3 **1996.**

4 (a) *SHORT TITLE.*—*This Act may be cited as the “Om-*  
5 *nibus Parks Technical Corrections Act of 1999”.*

6 (b) *REFERENCE TO OMNIBUS PARKS ACT.*—*In this*  
7 *Act, the term “Omnibus Parks Act” means the Omnibus*  
8 *Parks and Public Lands Management Act of 1996 (Public*  
9 *Law 104–333; 110 Stat. 4093).*

10 **TITLE I—TECHNICAL**

 25 *RIOR.—The Secretary of the Interior shall transfer to*

1        *the Secretary of Agriculture administrative jurisdic-*

3        *terests in land located in Duchesne and Wasatch*  
4        *Counties, Utah, that were acquired by the Secretary*  
5        *of the Interior for the Central Utah Project, as de-*  
6        *icted on the maps entitled—*

7                *“(A) the ‘Dutch John Townsite, Ashley Na-*  
8                *tional Forest, Lower Stillwater’, dated February*  
9                *1997;*

10               *“(B) The ‘Dutch John Townsite, Ashley Na-*  
11               *tional Forest, Red Hollow (Diamond Prop-*  
12               *erties)’, dated February 1997; and*

13               *“(C) The ‘Dutch John Townsite, Ashley Na-*  
14               *tional Forest, Coal Hollow (Current Creek Res-*  
15               *ervoir)’, dated February 1997.*

16               *“(2) TRANSFER FROM SECRETARY OF AGRIC-*  
17               *CULTURE.—The Secretary of Agriculture shall trans-*  
18               *fer to the Secretary of the Interior administrative ju-*  
19               *risdiction over approximately 2,450 acres of lands*  
20               *and interests in lands located in the Ashley National*  
21               *Forest, as depicted on the map entitled ‘Ashley Na-*  
22               *tional Forest, Lands to be Transferred to the Bureau*  
23               *of Reclamation (BOR) from the Forest Service’, dated*  
24               *February 1997.”.*

1           (3) *In paragraph (3)(A), by striking the second*  
2           *sentence and inserting the following new sentence:*

10          (b) *ELECTRIC POWER.—Section 13(d) of such Act (112*  
11          *Stat. 3053) is amended by striking paragraph (1) and in-*

14                 *make available for the Dutch John community electric*  
15                 *power and associated energy previously reserved from*

18          **SEC. 304. OREGON PUBLIC LANDS TRANSFER AND PROTEC-**  
19                         **TION ACT OF 1998.**

20          *Section 3 of the Oregon Public Lands Transfer and*  
21          *Protection Act of 1998 (Public Law 105–321; 112 Stat.*  
22          *3022) is amended as follows:*

23                 (1) *In subsection (a), by striking paragraph (3)*  
24                 *and redesignating paragraphs (4) and (5) as para-*  
25                 *graphs (3) and (4), respectively.*

1           (2) *By striking subsection (b) and inserting the*  
2           *following new subsection:*

3           “(b) *POLICY OF NO NET LOSS OF O & C LAND AND*  
4           *CBWR LAND.—In carrying out sales, purchases, and ex-*  
5           *changes of land in the geographic area, the Secretary shall*  
6           *ensure that on October 30, 2008, and on the expiration of*  
7           *each 10-year period thereafter, the number of acres of O*  
8           *& C land and CBWR land in the geographic area is not*  
9           *less than the number of acres of such land on October 30,*  
10          *1998.”.*

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to make technical corrections to the Omnibus Parks and Public Lands Management Act of 1996 and to other laws related to parks and public lands.”.
