3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The United States courthouse building located at 402
5 North Walnut Street and Prospect Avenue in Harrison,
6 Arkansas, is hereby designated as the “Judge J. Smith
7 Henley Federal Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, regulation, map, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the United
4 States courthouse building referred to in section 1 shall
5 be considered to be a reference to the “Judge J. Smith
6 Henley Federal Building”.
