3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF PAMELA B. GWIN HALL.**

4 The Federal facility located at 1301 Emmet Street
5 in Charlottesville, Virginia, shall be known and designated
6 as the “Pamela B. Gwin Hall”.

7 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

8 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
9 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal

1 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to ref-
2 erence to the “Pamela B. Gwin Hall”.
