A BILL

To terminate certain sanctions with respect to India and Pakistan.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF CERTAIN SANCTIONS WITH
- 4 RESPECT TO INDIA AND PAKISTAN.
- 5 (a) India and Pakistan.—Effective on the date of
- 6 the enactment of this Act, the sanctions contained in the
- 7 following provisions of law shall not apply to India and
- 8 Pakistan, with respect to any grounds for the imposition

- 1 of sanctions under those provisions arising before such
- 2 date of enactment:
- 3 (1) Section 101 of the Arms Export Control
- 4 Act (22 U.S.C. 2799aa).
- 5 (2) Section 102 of the Arms Export Control
- 6 Act (22 U.S.C. 2799aa–1).
- 7 (3) Section 2(b)(4) of the Export-Import Bank
- 8 Act of 1945 (12 U.S.C. 635(b)(4)).
- 9 (b) CERTAIN PERSONS.—Effective on the date of the
- 10 enactment of this Act, the sanctions contained in sections
- 11 821 and 824 of the Nuclear Proliferation Prevention Act
- 12 (22 U.S.C. 3201 note) shall not apply to any person, with
- 13 respect to any grounds for the imposition of sanctions
- 14 under those provisions arising before such date of enact-
- 15 ment, relating to the detonation by India or Pakistan of
- 16 nuclear explosive devices.
- 17 (c) STATUTORY CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this
- 18 Act prohibits the imposition of sanctions by the President
- 19 under any provision of law specified in subsections (a) and
- 20 (b) by reason of any grounds for the imposition of sanc-
- 21 tions under that provision of law arising on or after the
- 22 date of the enactment of this Act.
- 23 SEC. 2. REPEALS.
- The India-Pakistan Relief Act of 1988 (title IX of
- 25 the Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Ad-

- 1 ministration, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act,
- $2\,$ 1999, as contained in section 101(a) of Public Law 105–

3 277), is repealed.
