AN ACT

To amend title 18, United States Code, to provide penalties for harming animals used in Federal law enforcement.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Federal Law Enforce-
- 3 ment Animal Protection Act of 1999".
- 4 SEC. 2. HARMING ANIMALS USED IN LAW ENFORCEMENT.
- 5 (a) In General.—Chapter 65 of title 18, United
- 6 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 7 lowing:

8 "§ 1368. Harming animals used in law enforcement

- 9 "(a) Whoever willfully and maliciously harms any po-
- 10 lice animal, or attempts or conspires to do so, shall be
- 11 fined under this title and imprisoned not more than one
- 12 year. If the offense permanently disables or disfigures the
- 13 animal, or causes serious bodily injury or the death of the
- 14 animal, the maximum term of imprisonment shall be 10
- 15 years.
- 16 "(b) In this section, the term 'police animal' means
- 17 a dog or horse employed by a Federal agency (whether
- 18 in the executive, legislative, or judicial branch) for the
- 19 principal purpose of aiding in the detection of criminal ac-
- 20 tivity, enforcement of laws, or apprehension of criminal
- 21 offenders.".
- 22 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
- 23 at the beginning of chapter 65 of title 18, United States

- 1 Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new
- 2 item:

"1368. Harming animals used in law enforcement.".
