To amend title 18, United States Code, to punish the depiction of animal cruelty.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

3 SECTION 1. PUNISHMENT FOR DEPICTION OF ANIMAL CRU-

4 **ELTY.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 3 of title 18, United
6 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol7 lowing:

8 "§ 48. Depiction of animal cruelty

9 "(a) CREATION, SALE, OR POSSESSION.—Whoever 10 knowingly creates, sells, or possesses a depiction of animal cruelty with the intention of placing that depiction in
 interstate or foreign commerce for commercial gain, shall
 be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than 5
 years, or both.

5 "(b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section—

6 "(1) the term 'depiction of animal cruelty' 7 means any visual or auditory depiction, including 8 any photograph, motion-picture film, video record-9 ing, electronic image, or sound recording of conduct 10 in which a living animal is intentionally maimed, 11 mutilated, tortured, wounded, or killed, if such con-12 duct is illegal under Federal law or the law of the 13 State in which the creation, sale, or possession takes 14 place, regardless of whether the maining, mutila-15 tion, torture, wounding, or killing took place in the 16 State; and

"(2) the term 'State' means each of the several
States, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth
of Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, Guam, American
Samoa, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana
Islands, and any other commonwealth, territory, or
possession of the United States.".
