## A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to prohibit sex offenders from entering National Parks.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Safe Parks Act of  
5 1999”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITING SEX OFFENDERS FROM ENTERING**  
7 **NATIONAL PARKS.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 91 of title 18, United  
9 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
10 lowing:

1 **“§ 1865. Sex offenders prohibited from entering na-**  
2 **tional parks**

3 “Whoever, being a person required to register under  
4 section 107101 of the Violent Crime Control and Law En-  
5 forcement Act of 1994 (42 U.S.C. 14071), knowingly en-  
6 ters into a unit of the National Park System, as defined  
7 in section 2(a) of the Act of August 8, 1953 (Chapter 384,  
8 67 Stat. 496) shall be fined under this title or imprisoned  
9 not more than 3 years, or both.”.

10 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections  
11 at the beginning of chapter 91 of title 18, United States  
12 Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new  
13 item:

“1865. Sex offenders prohibited from entering national parks.”.
