In the House of Representatives, U. S.,

November 9, 1999.

Resolved, That the House agree to the amendment of the Senate to the bill (H.R. 2280) entitled “An Act to amend title 38, United States Code, to provide a cost-of-living adjustment in rates of compensation paid for service-connected disabilities, to enhance the compensation, memorial affairs, and housing programs of the Department of Veterans Affairs, to improve retirement authorities applicable to judges of the United States Court of Appeals for Veterans Claims, and for other purposes”, with the following

AMENDMENTS:

1 ***SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE; REFERENCES TO TITLE 38,***
2 ***UNITED STATES CODE.***

3 *(a) SHORT TITLE.—This Act may be cited as the “Vet-*
4 *erans’ Compensation Cost-of-Living Adjustment Act of*
5 *1999”.*

6 *(b) REFERENCES TO TITLE 38, UNITED STATES*
7 *CODE.—Except as otherwise expressly provided, whenever*
8 *in this Act an amendment or repeal is expressed in terms*
9 *of an amendment to, or repeal of, a section or other provi-*

1 sion, the reference shall be considered to be made to a section
2 or other provision of title 38, United States Code.

3 **SEC. 2. DISABILITY COMPENSATION.**

22 *tion 10 of Public Law 85–857 who are not in receipt of*
23 *compensation payable pursuant to chapter 11 of title 38,*
24 *United States Code.*

²If the veteran served as Chairman or Vice-Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, Chief of Staff of the Army, Chief of Naval Operations, Chief of Staff of the Air Force, Commandant of the Marine Corps, or Commandant of the Coast Guard, at the applicable time designated by section 1302 of this title, the surviving spouse’s rate shall be \$2,013.”.
