## AN ACT

To reauthorize the Junior Duck Stamp Conservation and  
Design Program Act of 1994.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REAUTHORIZATION OF JUNIOR DUCK STAMP**  
2 **CONSERVATION AND DESIGN PROGRAM ACT**  
3 **OF 1994.**

4 Section 5 of the Junior Duck Stamp Conservation  
5 and Design Program Act of 1994 (16 U.S.C. 719e) is  
6 amended by striking “for each of the fiscal years 1995  
7 through 2000” and inserting “for each of the fiscal years  
8 2001 through 2005”.

9 **SEC. 2. EXPANSION OF PROGRAM TO INSULAR AREAS.**

10 The Junior Duck Stamp Conservation and Design  
11 Program Act of 1994 is amended—

12 (1) in section 2(c) (16 U.S.C. 719(c)) by strik-  
13 ing “50 States” each place it appears and inserting  
14 “States”;

15 (2) by redesignating section 5 (16 U.S.C.  
16 719e), as amended by section 1 of this Act, as sec-  
17 tion 6; and

18 (3) by inserting after section 4 the following:

19 **“SEC. 5. DEFINITION OF STATE.**

20 “For the purposes of this Act, the term ‘State’ in-  
21 cludes the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of  
22 Puerto Rico, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana

1 Islands, American Samoa, Guam, the Virgin Islands, and  
2 any other territory or possession of the United States.”.

1999.
