1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

# 1SECTION 1. REAUTHORIZATION OF JUNIOR DUCK STAMP2CONSERVATION AND DESIGN PROGRAM ACT3OF 1994.

4 Section 5 of the Junior Duck Stamp Conservation
5 and Design Program Act of 1994 (16 U.S.C. 719c) is
6 amended by striking "for each of the fiscal years 1995
7 through 2000" and inserting "for each of the fiscal years
8 2001 through 2005".

#### 9 SEC. 2. EXPANSION OF PROGRAM TO INSULAR AREAS.

10 The Junior Duck Stamp Conservation and Design11 Program Act of 1994 is amended—

(1) in section 2(c) (16 U.S.C. 719(c)) by striking "50 States" each place it appears and inserting
"States";

15 (2) by redesignating section 5 (16 U.S.C.
16 719c), as amended by section 1 of this Act, as section 6; and

18 (3) by inserting after section 4 the following:

### 19 "SEC. 5. DEFINITION OF STATE.

20 "For the purposes of this Act, the term 'State' in21 cludes the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of
22 Puerto Rico, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana

1 Islands, American Samoa, Guam, the Virgin Islands, and

2 any other territory or possession of the United States.".
