A BILL

To direct the Administrator of General Services to acquire a building located in Terre Haute, Indiana, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. ACQUISITION OF BUILDING.
- 4 (a) Acquisition.—The Administrator of General
- 5 Services shall acquire by transfer from the United States
- 6 Postal Service the real property and improvements located
- 7 at 30 North Seventh Street in Terre Haute, Indiana.

- 1 (b) Reimbursement.—The transfer under sub-
- 2 section (a) shall be made without reimbursement, except
- 3 that the Administrator shall provide to the Postal Service
- 4 an option to occupy 8,000 square feet of renovated space
- 5 in the building acquired under subsection (a) at no cost
- 6 for a 20-year term.

7 SEC. 2. RENOVATION OF BUILDING.

- 8 (a) In General.—The Administrator of General
- 9 Services shall renovate the building acquired under section
- 10 1, and acquire parking spaces, to accommodate use of the
- 11 building by the Administrator and the United States Post-
- 12 al Service.
- 13 (b) Authorization of Appropriations.—Subject
- 14 to the requirements of section 7(a) of the Public Buildings
- 15 Act of 1959 (40 U.S.C. 606(a)), there is authorized to
- 16 be appropriated to carry out this section \$5,000,000 for
- 17 fiscal years beginning after September 30, 1999. Such
- 18 sums shall remain available until expended.
