A BILL

To direct the Administrator of General Services to acquire a building located in Terre Haute, Indiana, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ACQUISITION OF BUILDING.**

4 (a) ACQUISITION.—The Administrator of General
5 Services shall acquire by transfer from the United States
6 Postal Service the real property and improvements located
7 at 30 North Seventh Street in Terre Haute, Indiana.

1 (b) REIMBURSEMENT.—The transfer under sub-
2 section (a) shall be made without reimbursement, except
3 that the Administrator shall provide to the Postal Service
4 an option to occupy 8,000 square feet of renovated space
5 in the building acquired under subsection (a) at no cost
6 for a 20-year term.

7 **SEC. 2. RENOVATION OF BUILDING.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator of General
9 Services shall renovate the building acquired under section
10 1, and acquire parking spaces, to accommodate use of the
11 building by the Administrator and the United States Post-
12 al Service.

13 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Subject
14 to the requirements of section 7(a) of the Public Buildings
15 Act of 1959 (40 U.S.C. 606(a)), there is authorized to
16 be appropriated to carry out this section \$5,000,000 for
17 fiscal years beginning after September 30, 1999. Such
18 sums shall remain available until expended.
