A BILL

To amend the Woodrow Wilson Memorial Bridge Authority Act of 1995 to provide an authorization of contract authority for fiscal years 2004 through 2007, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Woodrow Wilson
5 Bridge Financing Act of 1999”.

1 **SEC. 2. ADVANCE AUTHORIZATION OF CONTRACT AUTHOR-**
2 **ITY FOR THE WOODROW WILSON BRIDGE.**

3 (a) FEDERAL CONTRIBUTION.—Section 412(a)(1) of
4 the Woodrow Wilson Memorial Bridge Authority Act of
5 1995 (109 Stat. 627; 112 Stat. 159) is amended—

6 (1) by striking “2002, and” and inserting
7 “2002,”; and

8 (2) by inserting “, and \$150,000,000 for each
9 of fiscal years 2004 through 2007” after “2003”.

10 (b) LIMITATION ON FEDERAL CONTRIBUTION.—Sec-
11 tion 412 of the Woodrow Wilson Memorial Bridge Author-
12 ity Act of 1995 (109 Stat. 627; 112 Stat. 159) is amended
13 by adding at the end the following:

14 “(d) LIMITATION ON FEDERAL CONTRIBUTION.—
15 The total amount made available from the Highway Trust
16 Fund under this section shall not exceed \$1,500,000,000.
17 Amounts from the Highway Trust Fund for the Project
18 in excess of \$1,500,000,000 shall be provided by the Cap-
19 ital Region jurisdictions.

20 “(e) CONTRIBUTIONS BY CAPITAL REGION JURISDIC-
21 TIONS.—

22 “(1) IN GENERAL.—For each of fiscal years
23 2004 through 2007, every \$1 provided from the
24 Highway Trust Fund under this section shall be
25 matched by at least \$0.67 provided by the Capital
26 Region jurisdictions from amounts made available to

1 the jurisdictions under title 23, United States Code,
2 or from other sources available to the jurisdictions.

3 “(2) ALLOCATION.—The Capital Region juris-
4 dictions shall allocate payment of the matching
5 funds required under paragraph (1) as the jurisdic-
6 tions determine to be appropriate.”.

7 **SEC. 3. AMENDMENT OF TRUST FUND CODE.**

8 Section 9503(c)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code of
9 1986 (relating to expenditures from the Highway Trust
10 Fund) is amended—

11 (1) in the first sentence—

12 (A) by inserting “(except for expenditures
13 provided for under subparagraph (F))” after
14 “2003”;

15 (B) in subparagraph (D), by striking “or”
16 at the end;

17 (C) in subparagraph (E), by striking the
18 period at the end and inserting “, or”; and

19 (D) by adding at the end the following:

20 “(F) authorized to be paid out of the
21 Highway Trust Fund under the Woodrow Wil-
22 son Memorial Bridge Authority Act of 1995
23 (109 Stat. 627).”; and

1 (2) in the second sentence, by striking “TEA
2 21 Restoration Act” and inserting “Woodrow Wilson
3 Bridge Financing Act of 1999”.

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
