"(5) JACKSON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.—Provision 1 2 of an alternative water supply and a project for the 3 elimination or control of combined sewer overflows for Jackson County, Mississippi.". 4 5 (b) ELIZABETH AND NORTH HUDSON, NEW JER-6 SEY.—Subsection (f) of section 219 of the Water Re-7 sources Development Act of 1992 is amended: 8 (1)in paragraph (33)by striking "\$20,000,000" and inserting "\$10,000,000"; 9 10 (2) in paragraph (34) by striking \$10,000,000" and inserting \$20,000,000"; and 11

(3) in paragraph (34) by striking "city of
North Hudson" and inserting "for the North Hudson Sewerage Authority".

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
