- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as "Kristen's Act".

SEC. 2. GRANTS FOR THE ASSISTANCE OF ORGANIZATIONS 2 TO FIND MISSING ADULTS. 3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Attorney General may make grants to public agencies or nonprofit private organiza-4 5 tions, or combinations thereof, for programs— 6 (1) to assist law enforcement and families in lo-7 cating missing adults; 8 (2) to maintain a national, interconnected data-9 base for the purpose of tracking missing adults who 10 are determined by law enforcement to be endangered 11 due to age, diminished mental capacity, or the cir-12 cumstances of disappearance, when foul play is sus-13 pected or circumstances are unknown; (3) to maintain statistical information of adults 14 15 reported as missing; 16 (4) to provide informational resources and re-17 ferrals to families of missing adults; 18 (5) to assist in public notification and victim 19 advocacy related to missing adults; and 20 (6) to establish and maintain a national clear-21 inghouse for missing adults. 22 (b) REGULATIONS.—The Attorney General may make 23 such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry 24 out this Act.

1 SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

- 2 There are authorized to be appropriated to carry out
- 3 this Act \$1,000,000 each year for fiscal years 2001
- 4 through 2004.
