## A BILL

To authorize the award of the Medal of Honor to Andrew J. Smith for acts of valor during the Civil War.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 SECTION 1. AUTHORITY FOR AWARD OF THE MEDAL OF
 HONOR TO ANDREW J. SMITH FOR VALOR
 DURING THE CIVIL WAR.
 (a) WAIVER OF TIME LIMITATIONS.—Notwith reading the time limitations generified in gestion 2744 of

7 standing the time limitations specified in section 3744 of
8 title 10, United States Code, or any other time limitation
9 with respect to the awarding of certain medals to persons
10 who served in the military service, the President may

award the Medal of Honor, posthumously, under section
 3741 of that title to Andrew J. Smith for the acts of valor
 referred to in subsection (b).

4 (b) ACTION DESCRIBED.—The acts of valor referred
5 to in subsection (a) are the actions of Andrew J. Smith
6 during the Civil War on November 30, 1864, while serving
7 as an infantry corporal in the 55th Massachusetts Vol8 untary Infantry during the Battle of Honey Hill in South
9 Carolina.
