Resolved, That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 2879) entitled "An Act to provide for the placement at the Lincoln Memorial of a plaque commemorating the speech of Martin Luther King, Jr., known as the 'I Have A Dream' speech.", do pass with the following

AMENDMENT:

Strike out all after the enacting clause and insert:

1 SECTION 1. PLACEMENT OF PLAQUE AT LINCOLN MEMO-

- 3 (a) Placement of Plaque.—
- 4 (1) In General.—The Secretary of the Interior
- 5 shall install in the area of the Lincoln Memorial in
- 6 the District of Columbia a suitable plaque to com-
- 7 memorate the speech of Martin Luther King, Jr.,
- 8 known as the "I Have A Dream" speech.
- 9 (2) Relation to commemorative works
- 10 ACT.—The Commemorative Works Act (40 U.S.C.

1	1001 et seq.) shall apply to the design and placement
2	of the plaque within the area of the Lincoln Memo-
3	rial.
4	(b) Acceptance of Contributions.—
5	(1) In General.—The Secretary of the Interior
6	is authorized to accept and expand contributions to-
7	ward the cost of preparing and installing the plaque,
8	without further appropriation. Federal funds may be
9	used to design, procure, or install the plaque.
