To amend the child and adult care food program under the National School Lunch Act to revise the eligibility of private organizations under that program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY OF PRIVATE ORGANIZATIONS**
4 **UNDER THE CHILD AND ADULT CARE FOOD**
5 **PROGRAM UNDER THE NATIONAL SCHOOL**
6 **LUNCH ACT.**

7 Section 17(a) of the National School Lunch Act (42
8 U.S.C. 1766(a)) is amended in the second sentence by
9 striking “for which it receives compensation from amounts
10 granted to the States under title XX of the Social Security

1 Act (but only if such organization receives compensation
2 under such title for at least 25 percent of its enrolled chil-
3 dren or 25 percent of its licensed capacity, whichever is
4 less)” and inserting “with at least 25 percent of the chil-
5 dren served by such organization who meet the income eli-
6 gibility criteria established under section 9(b) for free or
7 reduced price meals”.
