- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "National Amusement
- 5 Park Ride Safety Act of 1999".

3	Section 3(1) of the Consumer Product Safety Act (15
4	U.S.C. 2052(1)) is amended—
5	(1) in the second sentence, by striking ", and

7	(2) by striking the third sentence.
8	SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.
9	There are authorized to be appropriated to the Con-
10	sumer Product Safety Commission \$500,000 for each fis-
11	cal year to enable the Commission to carry out the Con-
12	sumer Product Safety Act as amended by section 2.
