A BILL

To provide for the protection of train employees.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.**

4 Section 21103 of title 49, United States Code, is
5 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
6 section:

7 “(d) **ADDITIONAL LIMITATION.**—A railroad carrier
8 and its officers and agents may not require a train em-
9 ployee who has been on duty or available for duty for any
10 portion of each of 7 consecutive days to go on duty or
11 be available for duty until at least 72 consecutive hours

- 1 have passed after the employee is released from duty or
- 2 from being available for duty.”.
