## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to issue regulations under the Migratory Bird Treaty Act that authorize States to establish hunting seasons for double-crested cormorants.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REGULATIONS FOR HUNTING SEASONS FOR
- 4 DOUBLE-CRESTED CORMORANTS.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Interior
- 6 shall, by not later than 6 months after the date of the
- 7 enactment of this Act, issue regulations under section 3
- 8 of the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (16 U.S.C. 704) that

- 2 authorize States to establish hunting seasons for double-2 crested cormorants. 3 (b) Content.—Regulations issued under this section shall— 5 (1) permit the taking by an individual of 10 6 double-crested cormorants during each day of a 7 hunting season established under the regulations; 8 (2) permit an individual to have in his or her 9 possession 20 double-crested cormorants legally 10 taken in a hunting season established under the reg-
  - (3) require that the dates of any hunting season established under the regulations in a State correspond generally with other waterfowl hunting seasons in that State; and
  - (4) subject to the other requirements of this subsection, authorize a hunting season established under the regulations to begin at any time after the date of the issuance of the regulations.
