A BILL

To permit the enrollment in the House of Representatives Child Care Center of children of Federal employees who are not employees of the legislative branch.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ENROLLMENT OF CHILDREN OF OTHER FED-**
4 **ERAL EMPLOYEES IN HOUSE OF REPRESENT-**
5 **ATIVES CHILD CARE CENTER.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 312(a)(1) of the Legisla-
7 tive Branch Appropriations Act, 1992 (40 U.S.C.
8 184g(a)) is amended—

1 (1) by striking “and” at the end of subpara-
2 graph (A);

3 (2) by striking the period at the end of sub-
4 paragraph (B) and inserting “; and”; and

5 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
6 paragraph:

7 “(C) if places are available after admission of
8 all children who are eligible under subparagraphs
9 (A) or (B), for children of employees of other offices,
10 departments, and agencies of the Federal govern-
11 ment.”.

12 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
13 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to children admit-
14 ted to the House of Representatives Child Care Center on
15 or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
