6	striking "including—" and inserting "including the

9	striking the semicolon at the end and inserting a pe-

11	(3) by adding at the end the following:
12	"(8)(A) Payment of expenses during the transi-
13	tion for briefings, workshops, or other activities to
14	acquaint key prospective Presidential appointees

16	typically confront new political appointees when they
