Mr. JENKINS introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Veterans' Affairs

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to release a reversionary interest of the United States in certain real property previously conveyed to the State of Tennessee.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RELEASE OF REVERSIONARY INTEREST OF THE**
4 **UNITED STATES IN CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY**
5 **PREVIOUSLY CONVEYED TO THE STATE OF**
6 **TENNESSEE.**

7 (a) RELEASE OF INTEREST.—The Secretary of Vet-
8 erans Affairs shall execute such legal instruments as nec-
9 essary to release the reversionary interest of the United

1 States described in subsection (b) in a certain parcel of
2 real property conveyed to the State of Tennessee pursuant
3 to the Act entitled “An Act authorizing the transfer of
4 certain property of the Veterans’ Administration (in John-
5 son City, Tennessee) to the State of Tennessee”, approved
6 June 6, 1953 (67 Stat. 54).

7 (b) SPECIFIED REVERSIONARY INTEREST.—Sub-
8 section (a) applies to the reversionary interest of the
9 United States required under section 2 of the Act referred
10 to in subsection (a), requiring use of the property con-
11 veyed pursuant to that Act to be primarily for training
12 of the National Guard and for other military purposes.

13 (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 2 of such
14 Act is repealed.
