Mr. UNDERWOOD introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Commerce

A BILL

To establish a standard time zone for Guam and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TIME ZONE ESTABLISHED.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The first section of the Act of
5 March 19, 1918 (15 U.S.C. 261; commonly known as the
6 Calder Act) is amended—

7 (1) in the first sentence, by striking “eight
8 zones” and inserting “nine zones”; and

9 (2) in the second sentence—

1 (A) by striking “; and that of the eighth”
2 and inserting “; that of the eighth”; and

3 (B) by inserting before the period the fol-
4 lowing: “; and that of the ninth zone on the one
5 hundred and fiftieth meridian of longitude east
6 from Greenwich.”.

7 (b) NAME OF ZONE.—Section 4 of the Act of March
8 19, 1918 (15 U.S.C. 263; commonly known as the Calder
9 Act) is amended—

10 (1) by striking “and that of the eighth” and in-
11 serting “that of the eighth”; and

12 (2) by inserting before the period the following:
13 “; and that of the ninth zone shall be known as
14 Chamorro standard time”.

15 (c) DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME.—Section 7 of the Uni-
16 form Time Act of 1966 (15 U.S.C. 267) is amended by
17 inserting “Guam, the Commonwealth of the Northern
18 Mariana Islands,” after “Puerto Rico,”.
