## AN ACT

To establish a standard time zone for Guam and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, and for other purposes.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. TIME ZONE ESTABLISHED.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The first section of the Act of  
3 March 19, 1918 (15 U.S.C. 261; commonly known as the  
4 Calder Act) is amended—

5 (1) in the first sentence, by striking “eight  
6 zones” and inserting “nine zones”; and

7 (2) in the second sentence—

8 (A) by striking “; and that of the eighth”  
9 and inserting “; that of the eighth”; and

10 (B) by inserting before the period the fol-  
11 lowing: “; and that of the ninth zone on the one  
12 hundred and fiftieth meridian of longitude east  
13 from Greenwich.”.

14 (b) NAME OF ZONE.—Section 4 of the Act of March  
15 19, 1918 (15 U.S.C. 263; commonly known as the Calder  
16 Act) is amended—

17 (1) by striking “and that of the eighth” and in-  
18 serting “that of the eighth”; and

19 (2) by inserting before the period the following:  
20 “; and that of the ninth zone shall be known as  
21 Chamorro standard time”.

22 (c) DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME.—Section 7 of the Uni-  
23 form Time Act of 1966 (15 U.S.C. 267) is amended by

1 inserting “Guam, the Commonwealth of the Northern  
2 Mariana Islands,” after “Puerto Rico,”.
