A BILL

To require that any city that is completely surrounded by any other city must be assigned its own ZIP codes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. ZIP CODE REQUIREMENT.

4 (a) REQUIREMENT.—Effective 1 year after the date 5 of enactment of this Act, no ZIP code that is assigned 6 to a city (or portion of a city) that is completely sur-7 rounded by any other city may also be assigned to any 8 area outside of the city so surrounded.

9 (b) DEFINITION.—For purposes of this section, the 10 term "city" means any unit of general local government that is classified as a city, town, or municipality by the
Bureau of the Census, and within the boundaries of which

3 5,000 or more individuals reside.
