## A BILL

To permit any individual who has attained 62 years of age to engage in recreational fishing in navigable waters in any State without obtaining a license.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RECREATIONAL FISHING BY SENIORS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Any individual who has attained  
5 62 years of age may, without obtaining a license, permit,  
6 or other authorization, engage in recreational fishing in  
7 any State under the same conditions and restrictions that  
8 apply under the laws of the State to an individual who

1 holds a license, permit, or other authorization for that  
2 fishing issued by the State.

3 (b) STATE DEFINED.—For purposes of this section,  
4 the term “State” includes the several States and the Dis-  
5 trict of Columbia.
