A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on iced teas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON ICED TEAS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.21.01	Preparations with a basis of extracts, essences, or concentrates of tea or mate, or with a basis of tea or mate, described in additional U.S. note 8 to chapter 7 and entered pursuant to its provisions (provided for in subheading 2101.20.54)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2003	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
