3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Quality Teacher Re-
5 cruitment Act of 2000”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCREASE IN AMOUNT OF STUDENT LOANS ELIGI-**
2 **BLE FOR FORGIVENESS FOR SERVICE AS A**
3 **TEACHER.**

4 (a) **GUARANTEED LOANS.**—Section 428J(c)(1) of the
5 Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1078–10(c)(1))
6 is amended by striking “\$5,000” and inserting
7 “\$17,750”.

8 (b) **DIRECT LOANS.**—Section 460(c)(1) of the Higher
9 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1087j(e)(1)) is amend-
10 ed by striking “\$5,000” and inserting “\$17,750”.
