

***In the Senate of the United States,***

*December 15 (legislative day, September 22), 2000.*

*Resolved,* That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 4020) entitled “An Act to authorize the addition of land to Sequoia National Park, and for other purposes.”, do pass with the following

**AMENDMENT:**

Strike out all after the enacting clause and insert:

1 **SECTION 1. ADDITION TO SEQUOIA NATIONAL PARK.**

2       (a) *IN GENERAL.*—As soon as practicable after the  
3 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior  
4 shall acquire by donation, purchase with donated or appro-  
5 priated funds, or exchange, all interest in and to the land  
6 described in subsection (b) for addition to Sequoia National  
7 Park, California.

8       (b) *LAND ACQUIRED.*—The land referred to in sub-  
9 section (a) is the land depicted on the map entitled  
10 “Dillonwood”, numbered 102/80,044, and dated September  
11 1999.

1           (c) *ADDITION TO PARK.*—*Upon acquisition of the land*  
2 *under subsection (a)—*

3           (1) *the Secretary of the Interior shall—*

4                   (A) *modify the boundaries of Sequoia Na-*  
5 *tional Park to include the land within the park;*  
6 *and*

7                   (B) *administer the land as part of Sequoia*  
8 *National Park in accordance with all applicable*  
9 *laws; and*

10           (2) *the Secretary of Agriculture shall modify the*  
11 *boundaries of the Sequoia National Forest to exclude*  
12 *the land from the forest boundaries.*
