Mr. RADANOVICH introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To authorize an expansion of the boundaries of Sequoia National Park to include Dillonwood Giant Sequoia Grove.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Dillonwood Giant Se-
5 quoa Grove Park Expansion Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. ADDITION TO SEQUOIA NATIONAL PARK.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—As soon as practicable after the
8 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior
9 shall acquire by donation, purchase with donated or appro-
10 priated funds, or exchange, all interest in and to the land

1 described in subsection (b) for addition to Sequoia Na-
2 tional Park, California.

3 (b) LAND ACQUIRED.—The land referred to in sub-
4 section (a) is the land depicted on the National Park Serv-
5 ice map entitled “Dillonwood”, numbered 10280044, and
6 dated September 1999.

7 (c) ADDITION TO PARK.—On acquisition of the land
8 under subsection (a), the Secretary shall—

9 (1) add the land to Sequoia National Park;

10 (2) modify the boundaries of Sequoia National
11 Park to include the land; and

12 (3) administer the land as part of Sequoia Na-
13 tional Park in accordance with all applicable law (in-
14 cluding regulations).
