AN ACT

To authorize the Secretary of the Treasury to produce currency, postage stamps, and other security documents at the request of foreign governments, and security documents at the request of the individual States or any political subdivision thereof, on a reimbursable basis, and for other purposes.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Bureau of Engraving
5	and Printing Security Printing Amendments Act of
6	2000".
7	SEC. 2. PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS FOR FOREIGN GOV-
8	ERNMENTS.
9	(a) In General.—Section 5114(a) of title 31,
10	United States Code (relating to engraving and printing
11	currency and security documents) is amended—
12	(1) by striking "(a) The Secretary of the Treas-
13	ury" and inserting:
14	"(a) Authority To Engrave and Print.—
15	"(1) In General.—The Secretary of the
16	Treasury''; and
17	(2) by adding at the end the following new
18	paragraph:
19	"(2) Engraving and printing for foreign
20	GOVERNMENTS.—The Secretary of the Treasury
21	may, if the Secretary determines that it will not
22	interfere with engraving and printing needs of the
23	United States—
24	"(A) produce currency, postage stamps,
25	and other security documents for foreign gov-

1	ernments, subject to a determination by the
2	Secretary of State that such production would
3	be consistent with the foreign policy of the
4	United States; and
5	"(B) produce security documents for
6	States and their political subdivisions.".
7	(b) Payment for Services.—Section 5143 of title
8	31, United States Code (relating to payment for services
9	of the Bureau of Engraving and Printing) is amended—
10	(1) in the first sentence, by inserting ", any for-
11	eign government, or any individual state or other po-
12	litical subdivision of any foreign government" after
13	"agency"; and
14	(2) in the last sentence, by inserting ", foreign
15	government, or individual state or other political
16	subdivision of a foreign government" after "agency".
